Review title

Video-based interventions for promoting positive social behaviour in children with autism spectrum disorders: a systematic review and meta-analysis

Review type

Campbell Collaboration intervention review of effectiveness

Review details

This systematic review will provide a thorough, objective, and authoritative summary of the evidence in relation to the effectiveness of Video-based Interventions (VBI). In almost four decades since the first published evidence of VBI for autism was reported (Steinborn & Knapp, 1982) a plethora of literature on the effects of VBI has amassed. However, little is known on which VBI is most effective, for whom, and why. Through exploratory moderator analysis, it is possible to synthesise data across this diverse set of interventions to ascertain the usefulness of each VBI and inform policy and practice.
